

What is the project?

The Veteran Plaza and Charles F. Kettering History Walk will be constructed at Delco Park, to honor all veterans who have served in one of the 5 branches of the military, Army, Navy, Marines, Air Force, and Coast Guard. The Charles F. Kettering history walk, will be an accessible walkway with 5 history stations positioned on the path. The stations will provide an overview of incredible contributions of Charles Kettering inventions and companies he was associated with that impacted the war efforts and the community.

The total project cost is estimated to be \$900,000 plus an establishment of a maintenance endowment fund.

The Kettering Park Foundation and Kettering Veterans & Inventor Campaign committee, with your help, will raise all the funds for this project through private contributions and/or in-kind contributions.

What is the Kettering Veterans & Inventor Campaign?

The Kettering Veterans & Inventor Campaign is a major fund raising effort by the Kettering Park Foundation and the campaign committee to support the fund raising portion of this project. All funds will be privately raised through this campaign effort.

What is the goal?

The goal is to raise an estimated \$900,000 through private donations and/or in-kind contributions by December 2015. All proceeds and contributions will go directly to the construction of the project.



What is the endowment fund?

The endowment fund will be established with a portion of the funds invested in perpetuity for future maintenance of the plaza and history walk. Distribution from the fund will be allocated for associated repair or replacement parts for the plaza and or history walk.

Who contributes to the fund?

Individuals and businesses in the community can contribute to the fund in cash. In-kind contributions can come through construction, material or labor donations. A limited number of brick pavers will be available for purchase and engraving veteran names.

Naming rights for the individual amenities of the project will be available. Stocks, bonds and cash will all be accepted. Current employees should check with their respective employer for matching fund gift options.

Is my gift tax-deductible?

Gifts to the campaign are fully tax deductible to the extent provided by the IRS regulations. Please check with your professional tax advisor with any questions. The Kettering Park Foundation is a certified 501(c)3 organization.
