National has increased the 2013 membership dues. Unfortunately this means we must raise ours too. Starting in 2013, senior renewals will be \$30.00 and new members will be \$35.00. Junior dues will remain the same. Many of you may have noticed there was no change in your continuous years on your 2012 card. National has changed their computer system. The new system will not add a year until payment is received.

There are 17 minor programs we also participate in (too many to name). Our fiscal year is May 1 – April 30. The majority of our treasury is depleted each year. Your volunteerism and participation has made this possible. Thank you to all.
