I was happy to have participated in the 2016 11th Annual American Legion Legacy Run starting at national headquarters in Indianapolis and traveling to the 98th American Legion Nation Convention in Cincinnati on August 25, 2016. On August 20 we gathered for safety training and dinner hosted by the Indiana American Legion Post 64. Sponsored by USAA, The Legacy Run is one of the largest multistate, multiday cross-country motorcycle events in the United States. More than 500 riders and passengers participated in this year's five-day event.

On August 21, National Commander Dale Barnett accompanied us through Indiana, Kentucky, Tennessee, Mississippi, Alabama, Georgia and Ohio on the way to Cincinnati. We finished our ride on the 25th when we arrived at lunchtime at Yeager-Benson Memorial American Legion Post 199 in Harrison, Ohio.

The Riders presented donations raised during the Legacy Run to Commander Barnett at the National Convention. I am very proud to announce that we raised \$1,155,363 for the American Legion Legacy Fund. The Legacy Fund provides college money for children of U.S. military personnel killed on active duty on or after September 11,2001, as well as the children of post-9/11 veterans with a VA disability rating of 50% or higher.
