From the Riders...

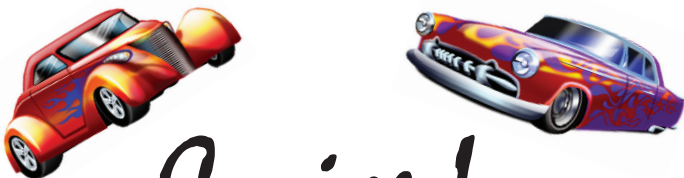
