Each year, the National American Legion establishes increased membership goals for Veteran, Auxiliary and SAL memberships. Since 2017,our membership quotas have increased approximately 200

and we have been successful meeting and exceeding those quotas. In addition to our annual incremental membership growth, we have seen an increase in the number of special events and greater participation by our current members at those special and recurring events. Our weekly hamburger, pizza and Friday nights are very busy and we are hearing from many members that they tried to attend but couldn't find a place to sit so they left. In addition, we continue to have a significant storage issue.

We can expect to continue to have incremental membership increases and can expect a

greater capacity issue in the future. The Post Executive Board is working on a plan to develop a possible expansion that might be necessary to accommodate membership and storage needs 4-5 years from now. We have worked with an architect and builder to draft one possible expansion plan that would provide more seating, more dancing space and an enhanced view of our property from inside the Post. We plan to place several renderings of the plan in our lobby during the end of February 2023 for all Veteran, Auxiliary and SAL members to view and leave comments on a special Comment Card.
