I am including a few of our end of year expenses for 2024: AES Ohio Electric: \$20, 235.25; Alcor paper supplies bar and kitchen \$21,151.01; Center point gas \$5,833.64; Montgomery Co. Water/Sewer \$6, 355.75; Rumpke \$ 7,344.62; Post property insurance \$24,018.60; Charitable donations and Veterans sponsored events \$ 255,443.74. This is only a portion of our annual expenses. We finished the year in the black financially. The reason for that is due to the great membership and officers we have.
